

Southgate Recreation & Park District COVID-19 District Operations Update March 9, 2021

In order to take precautions to protect the community, the District will be following information provided by the Federal Government, the California Department of Public Health, California Department of Industrial Relations (Cal OSHA), California Department of Social Services and Sacramento County Public Health, including wearing face coverings or face masks, maintaining at least 6-foot distance from others, avoiding unnecessary physical contact, and limiting gatherings of people from separate households.

The District has modified some recreation programs to be remote through the end of March 2021. Programs require preregistration and will take place via Zoom. WildHawk Golf Club is open and social distancing and disinfecting guidelines are being followed. The Grille is open for take-out and outdoor patio dining only. The Pro Shop will operate at no more than 20% capacity with entrance metering.

Parks

District parks remain open, including park playgrounds and exercise equipment. Physical conditioning, practice, skill-building, and training that can be conducted outdoors, with 6 feet of physical distancing, and within stable cohorts are authorized regardless of case rate or sport. Please enjoy our parks and trails during this situation while following hygiene and social distancing guidelines.

Gatherings - State of California Restrictions

Gatherings are social situations that bring together people from different households at the same time in a single space or place. Gatherings of up to three households are permitted while following mask and social distancing guidelines.

We are taking precautions advised by local, state and federal health officials for enhanced cleaning at our facilities. We encourage you to increase hygiene efforts to keep hands clean, avoid contact with faces, and remind all participants and employees to remain home if you or a member of your family show any flu-like symptoms.

While monitoring the evolving situation regarding COVID-19 we will continue to use the latest and best information to guide our decisions regarding programs and facilities in the coming weeks ahead.
